You will have friends in your class, these are the people you will be with all day. All classes will stay together during the school day, even outside.









Wait on the marked lines to line up Walk in the direction of the arrows And remind your adults to do the same

- Going home








Everyone will come into school wearing school uniform with trainers or other suitable shoes. You might bring a packed lunch, snack, water bottle, coat or sun hat with you but you are not allowed to bring anything else.





Everyone will come into school, through the front gate (on Bedwell Crescent) and go out using the back gate. There are arrows and markers to keep everyone at a safe distance. You will walk around to the classrooms, where your adults will meet you. Only children will come into the school building.



In your classroom you will have your own table and tray with everything you need. You can bring your water bottle into the classroom with you but you must leave your toys and pencil cases at home. Everything you need will be in school ready for you.







There will be lots of different learning tasks in school, some in the classroom, some in the ICT suite and some outside. All your learning books, papers and equipment will stay in school. You can bring a sun hat and have suncream put on before school, adults will not be able to help you put suncream on in school.







You will still be able to choose books to read. You will have a different box of books to choose from each day. All books will stay in school. You will not be able to pass books around or share them unfortunately.





Before snack and lunch you will clean your table (you might need some help) and your hands. Packed lunches will be brought to the classrooms.



At break time and lunch time, your bubble with have your own play equipment. You will help to keep it safe by washing your hands before and after you use it.



When it is time to be collected you and your class friends will go outside to be collected safely by your adult. You will walk out of the school by the back gate. Adults will not be allowed into the building, even if you can't find something. You must remind the adults that you are not allowed to play on the school grounds at the end of the day.



In school



- Stay with your bubble
- If you have medication, it will be kept in your classroom by the adults
- If you need First Aid your adults will help you





I will not be asked to take messages to any other classes, to the office or to run errands and it is fine for me to remind the adults of this if they forget!
