



Grace's mum shared that the Coptic Church celebrate the Virgin Mary in the month of August but she still loves celebrating it in May, as they did when she was a child in Italy.


In her village they used to gather around the Virgin Mary's grotto outside the Church and recite the Rosary all together.









# Salt dough solar system for a Space project






There may not be any caterpillars in Nursery this term but someone will be seeing butterflies soon







- \* This idea is another 'Pure Make', this means that you can use every part of the original materials without wasting anything or throwing anything away.
  - 1 Cut the middle out of a paper plate.




3 - Cut slits on the inside edge of the rim and pull these together to make it more 3D...

. . then arrange it like this.

4 - Cut an oval shape from the centre circle of the plate . . . keep the rest.



6 - Pull the head into a 3D shape and stick the eyes back in.





8 - Cut the last bits into triangles to make feet.

9 - Remember . . . if you have got any little bits of plate left, try to use them, I've made the feelers on mine a bit stronger.





10 - Now it's ready to pain
