


This week in Maths, Year 5 are learning to use dienes to help us learn about place values.



Class 5T also enjoying National Geographic for Kids this week.










Year 3 started their day with some French this week...

There are three groups of 20 minutes, two groups of 30 minutes and six groups of 10 minutes in one hour.









We also had fun looking for rivers and seas in the atlas this week.


Year 3 have also been listening to Gabriel Prokofiev's Concerto for Turntables and Orchestra this week then we had a go at making our own gestures on the table top.
