In Year 3 we have been talking about worries and what we can do so that our worry bag doesn't get too full.

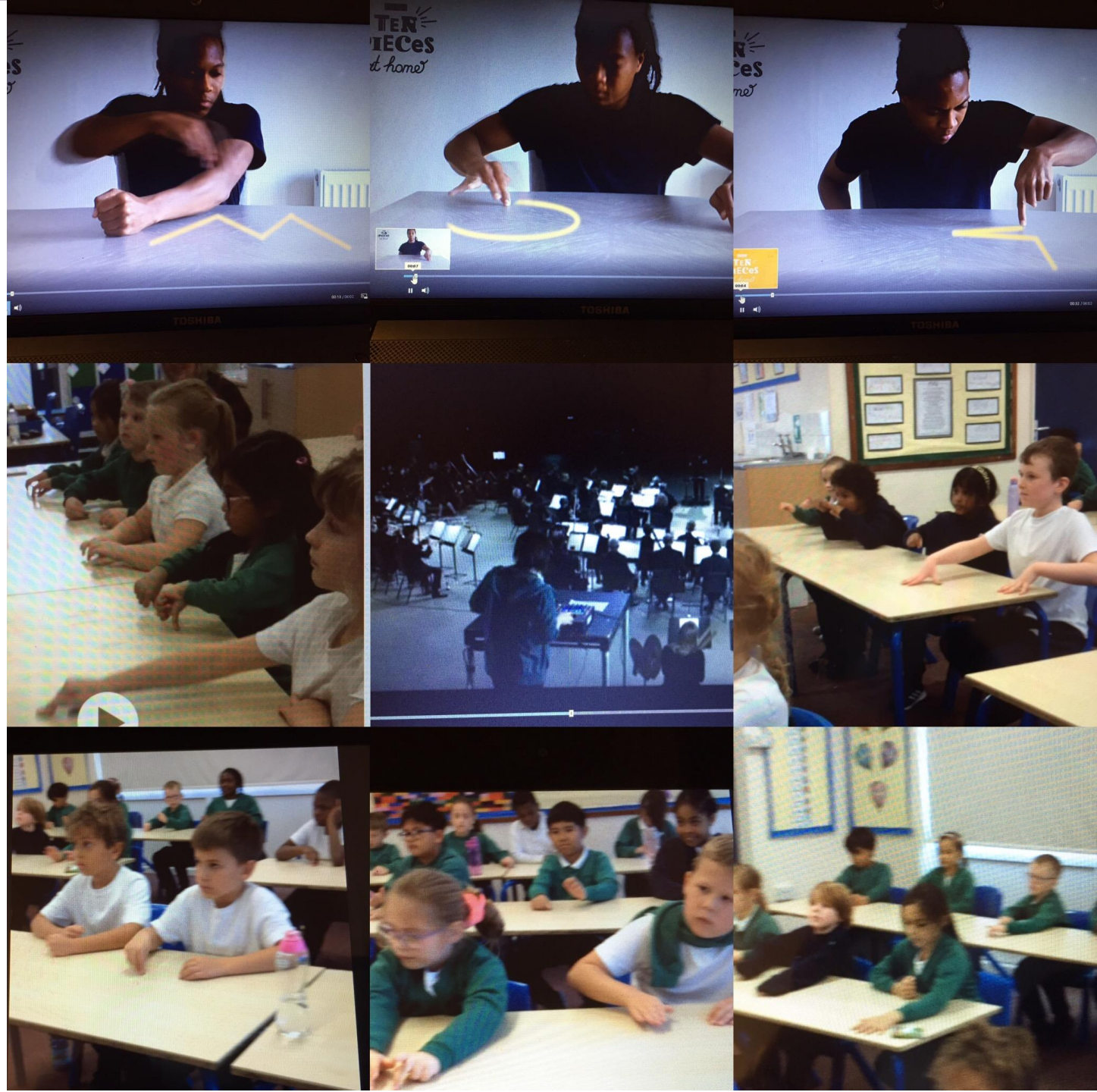
We use our learning pit a lot and are trying hard to have a go, as well as realising that it's ok to make a mistake.

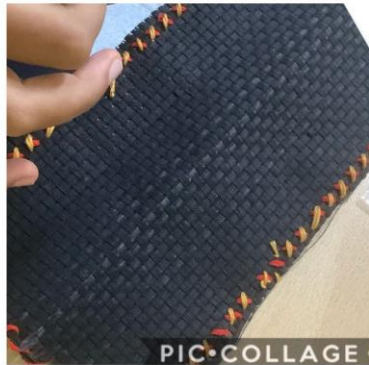
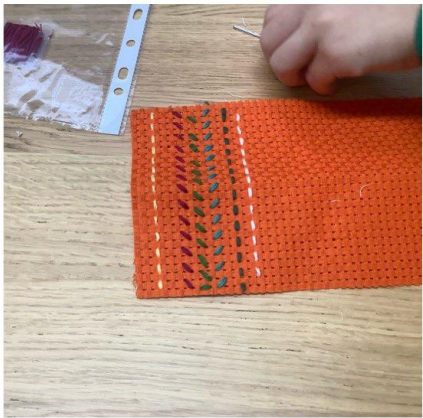
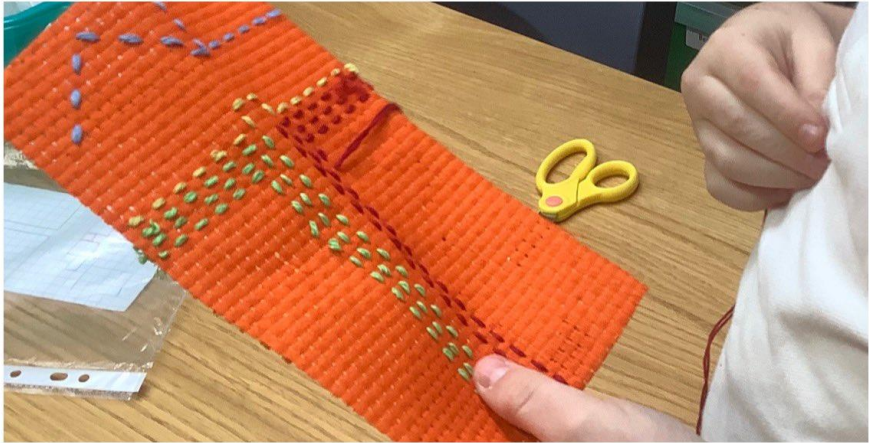
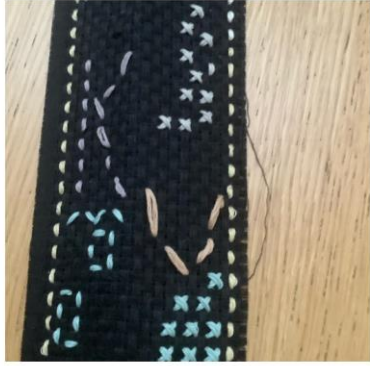
We also had fun looking for rivers and seas in the atlas this week.
