




- Welcome back to an exciting half term of learning!

A wonderful understanding of how our faith can lead to positive actions in Y5 this week...










On Tuesday the Nursery children were exploring dark and light.

ON THE WAY BACK THE NURSERY CHILDREN STOPPED TO SAY HELLO TO OUR LADY THE MOTHER OF JESUS.



















Year 3 enjoyed reading
