When it was our turn to look, we found 'Ourselves' inside




In this 'Be Spirited' activity we thought of special people that we love and created a class bubble to represent them all.











Stunning art work from one of our Year 5 pupils


It was beautiful to join with schools and Diocesan staff for a virtual Mass on Friday morning and a perfect way to end our term and to begin Holy Week.




Here are the details for the services across Stevenage in Holy Week and Easter



When Jesus and his disciples were on their way to Jerusalem, they came to the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of his disciples into the nearby village to collect a donkey.
