

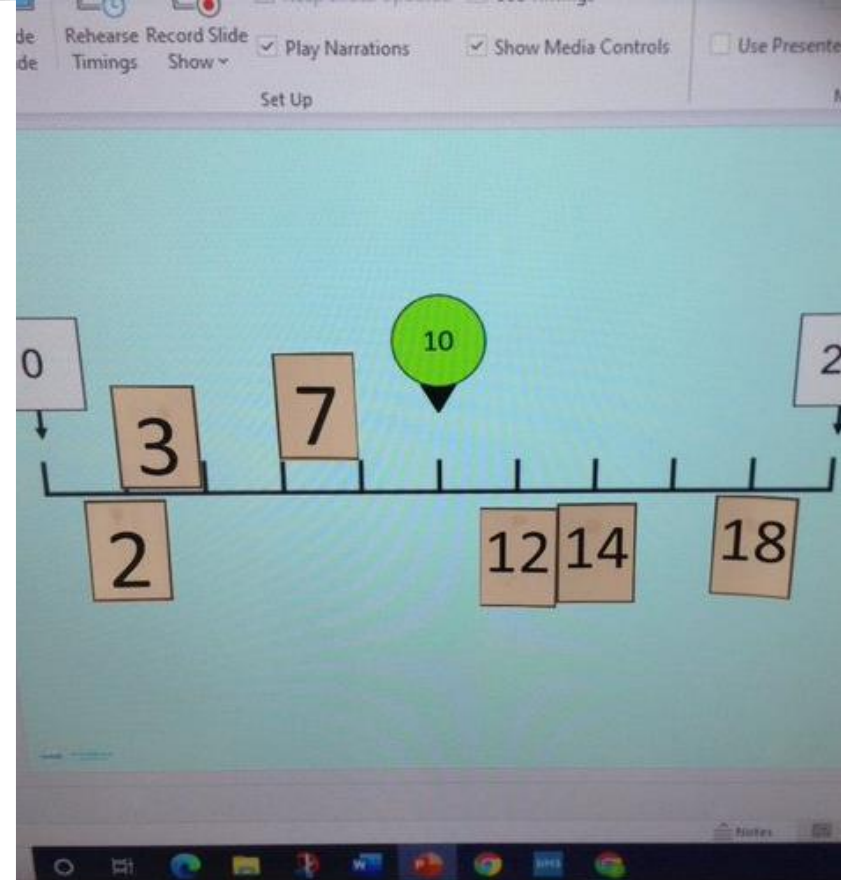




New reading books in Year Six Shakespeare this week.

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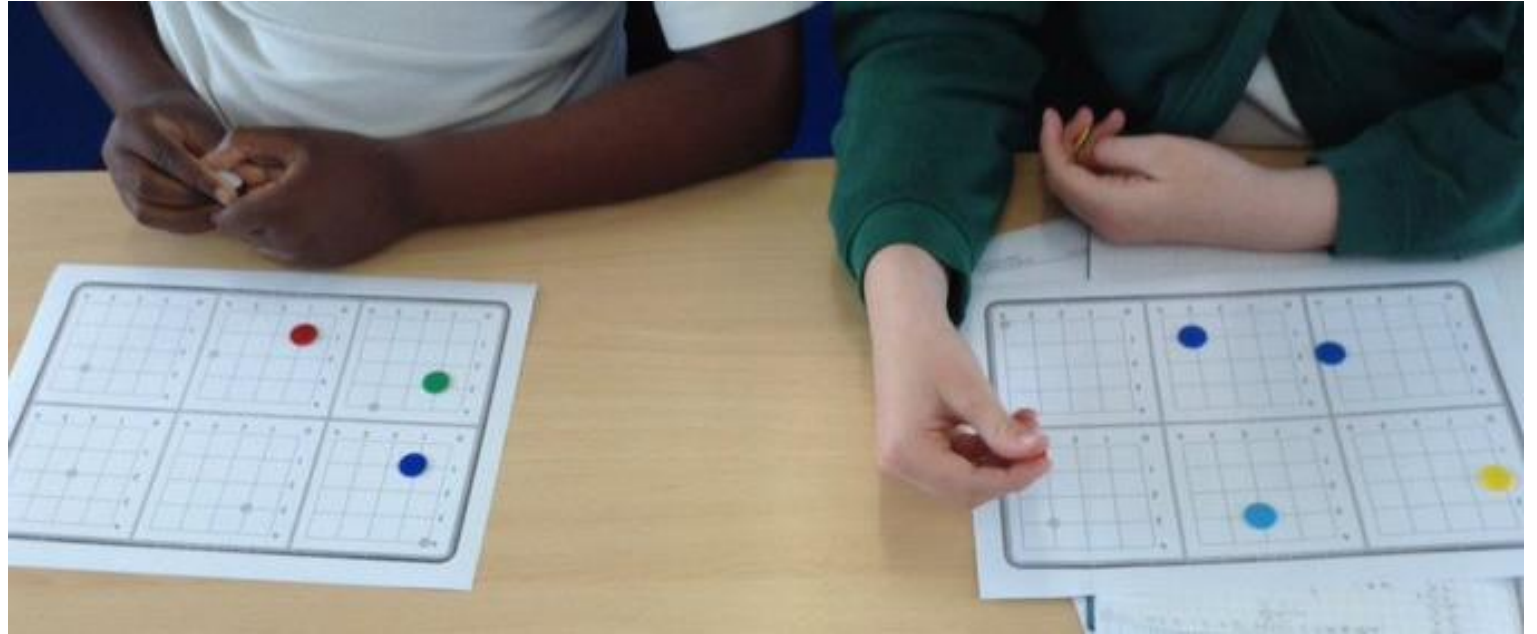
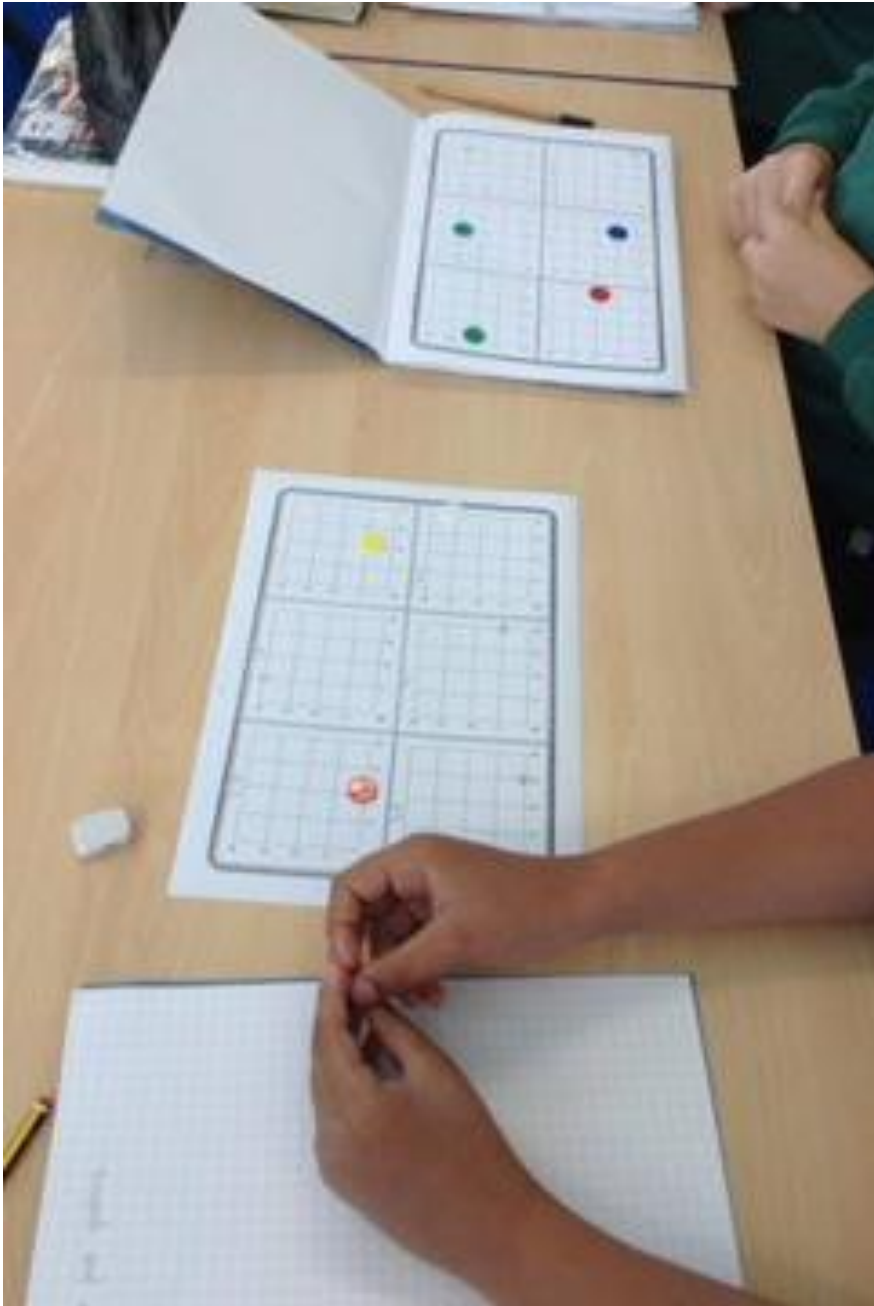

We enjoyed playing coordinates bingo in Year Six Shakespeare.

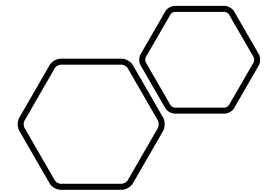
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In RE this week we are learning about the first miracle performed by Jesus.

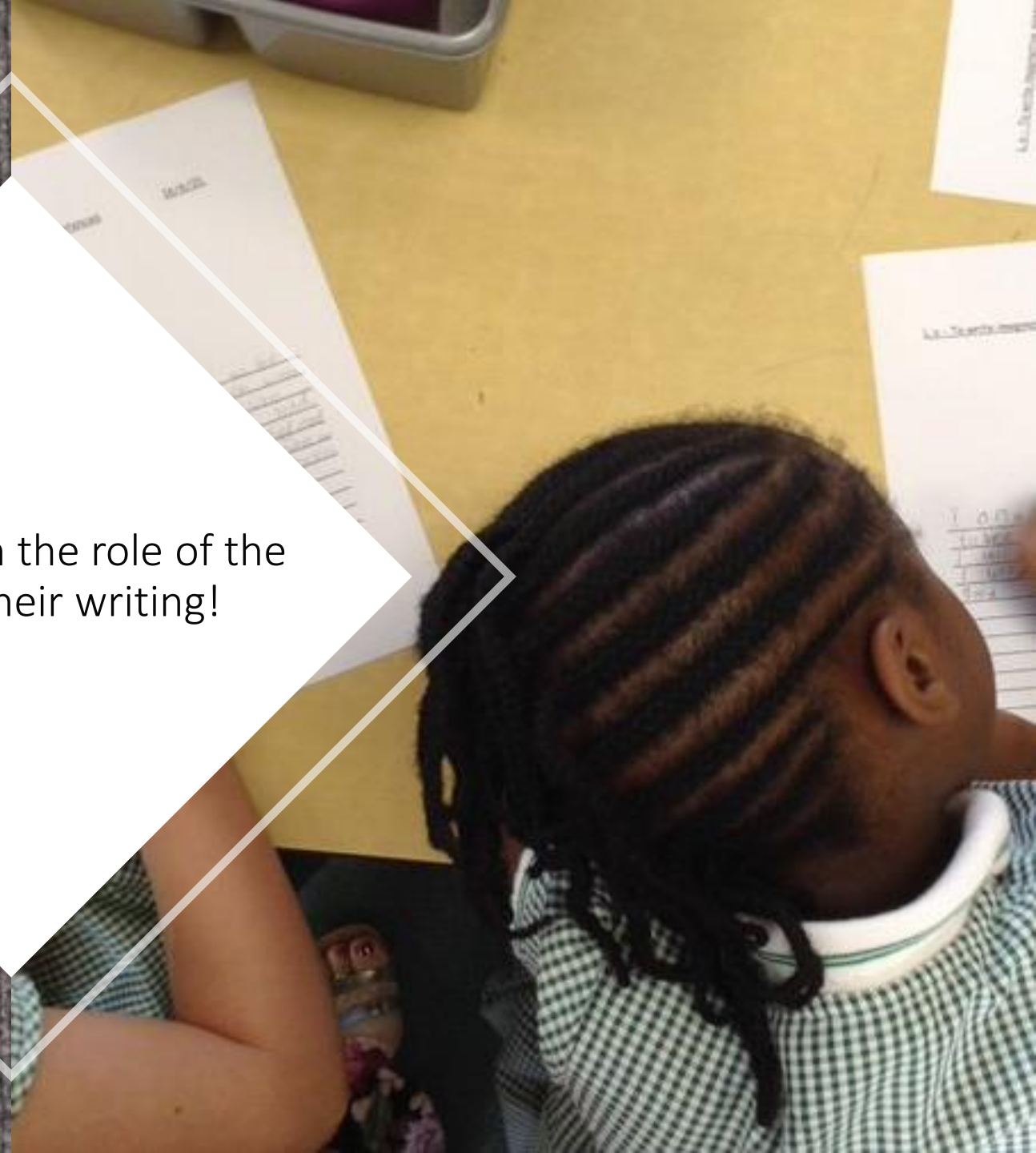

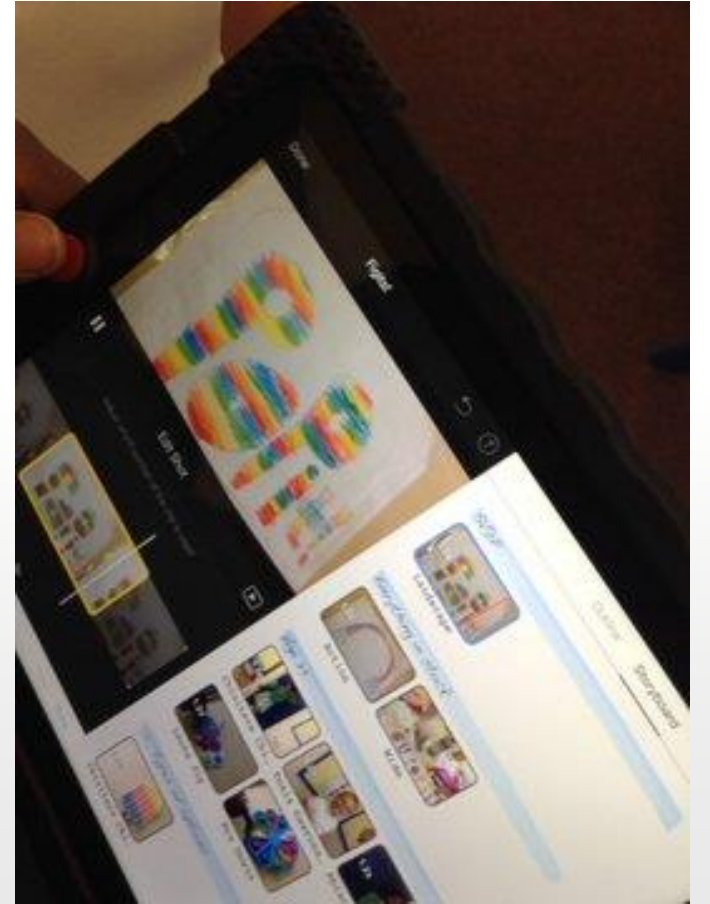

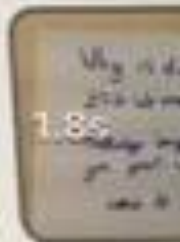

This morning we have been thinking about the church.

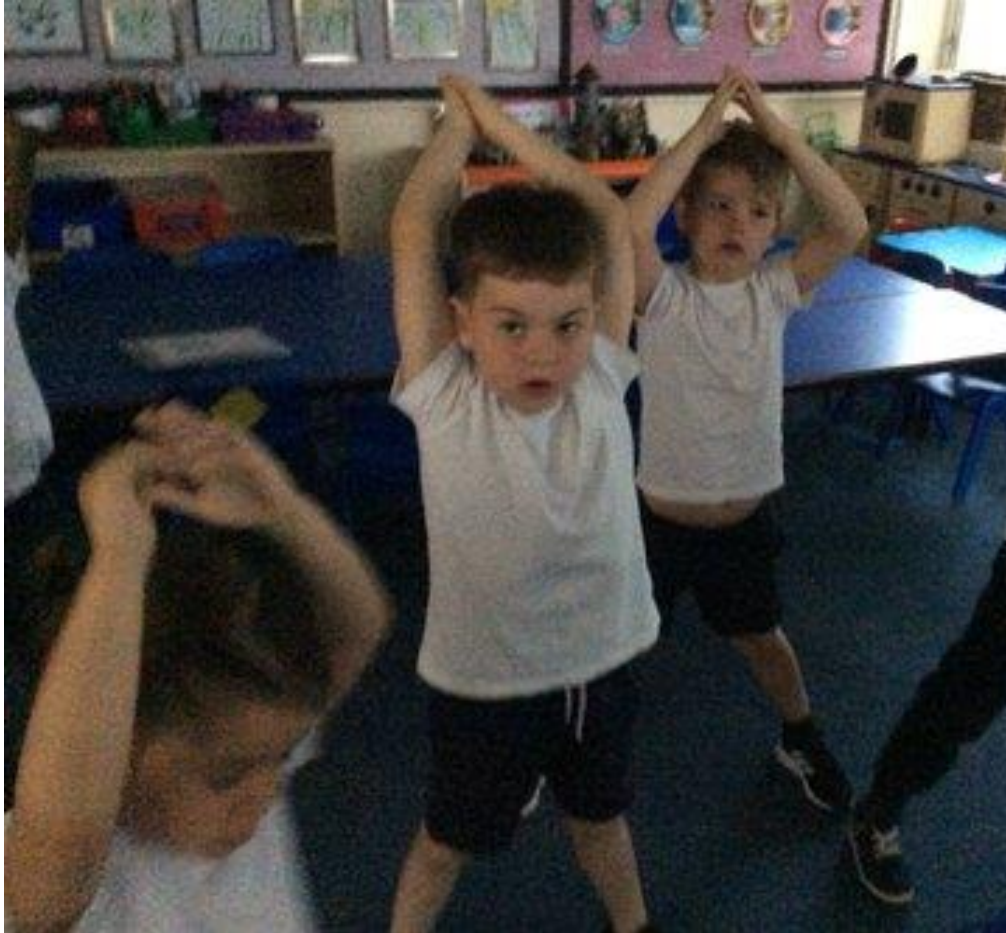

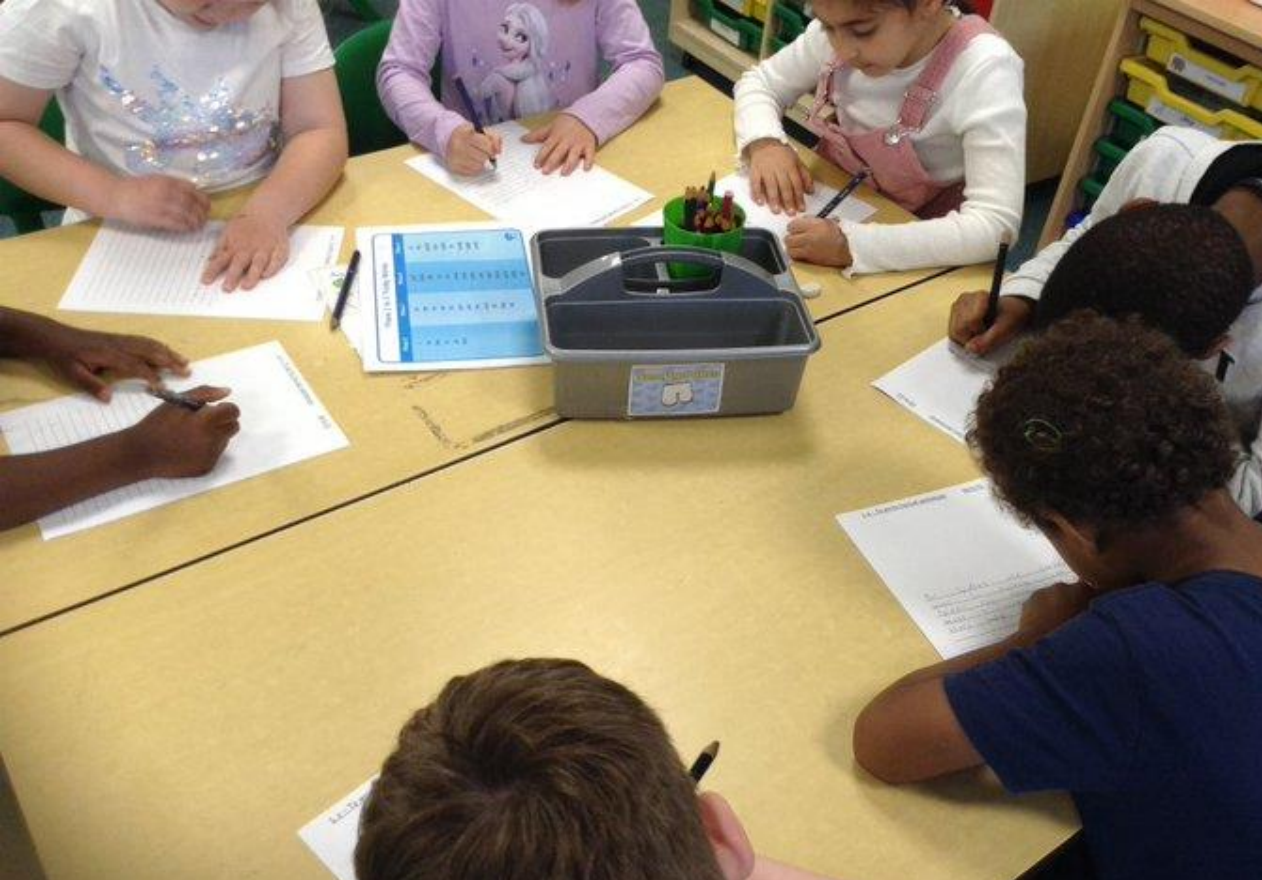
