




New reading books in Year Six Shakespeare this week.

Year 5A have enjoyed learning about Ephemeral Art. We have made our art work by foraging for our materials.











15th June The Well-being Woodland Walk has started!

15th June The Wellbeing Woodland Walk preparations underway in collaboration with @TheRedShedHerts and supported by @coopstevenage @StevenageTrust








We enjoyed playing coordinates bingo in Year Six Shakespeare.

Year 5 Agnesi enjoyed developing their cricket skills in the sunshine. Telling the time. Super partner work!




Year 3 have been so busy using iMovie to make adverts that will persuade others to buy their product or visit their place.














This morning we have been thinking about the church. *"The church…priest." "The church…Jesus." "I draw a person…a priest and that is the church!"*

Reception observed how roots grow by watering broad beans on paper towels












Well-being woodland path well on its way to being finished with great help from <u>@coopstevenage</u> volunteers and <u>@TheRedShedHerts</u>




Performing Rap poems in Y4 Michelangelo!

THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH Sunday 20th June 2021



Jesus said to his disciples, "Let us cross over to the other side of the Sea of Galilee." And leaving the crowd behind they set off. Then it began to blow a gale and the waves beat upon the boat so that it was almost filled with

water. Jesus was asleep in the stern of the boat, his head on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Master, do you not care? We are going down!" And he woke up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Quiet now! Be calm!" And the wind dropped, and all was calm again. Then he said to them, "Why are you so frightened? How is it that you have no faith?" They were filled with awe and said to one another, "Who can this be? Even the wind and the sea obey him."
