


PUPIL POST 27th June 2021 National Sports Week

We completed our Sports Day running races


Super effort and wonderful cheering!



Then we were busy writing our stories with a twist. Amazing writing stamina!






Year 3 have been cave painting. We have been studying The Stone Age & creating our own cave paintings.
