## The Sacrament of Reconciliation in Years 4, 5 & 6 on Thursday and Friday.





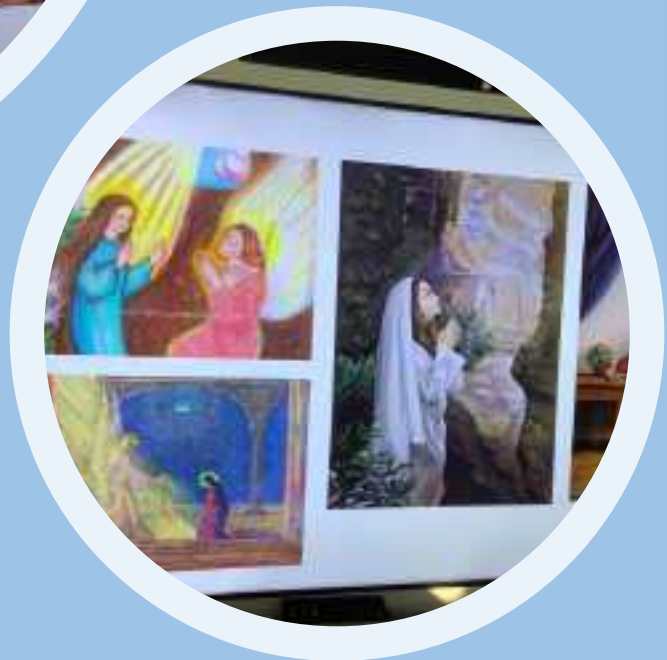
Thank you Father Nigel, Father Michael, Father Frank and Father Tom for guiding the children with such joy through the sacrament.

# THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH

SUNDAY 27<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2022



Jesus said, "A man had two sons. The younger said to his father, 'Father, let me have the inheritance that would come to me.' So the father gave him his share and his son then left for a distant country where he squandered his money on a life of shameless living. When he had spent it all, that country experienced a severe famine, and he began to be in need and he had to hire himself out to feed pigs. So he decided to go back to his father. When his father saw him, he ran to the boy, clasped him in his arms and kissed him. Then his son said, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I no longer deserve to be called your son.' But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring out the best robe and put it on him and kill the fattened calf. For this son of mine was lost and is now found.' And they began to celebrate."
