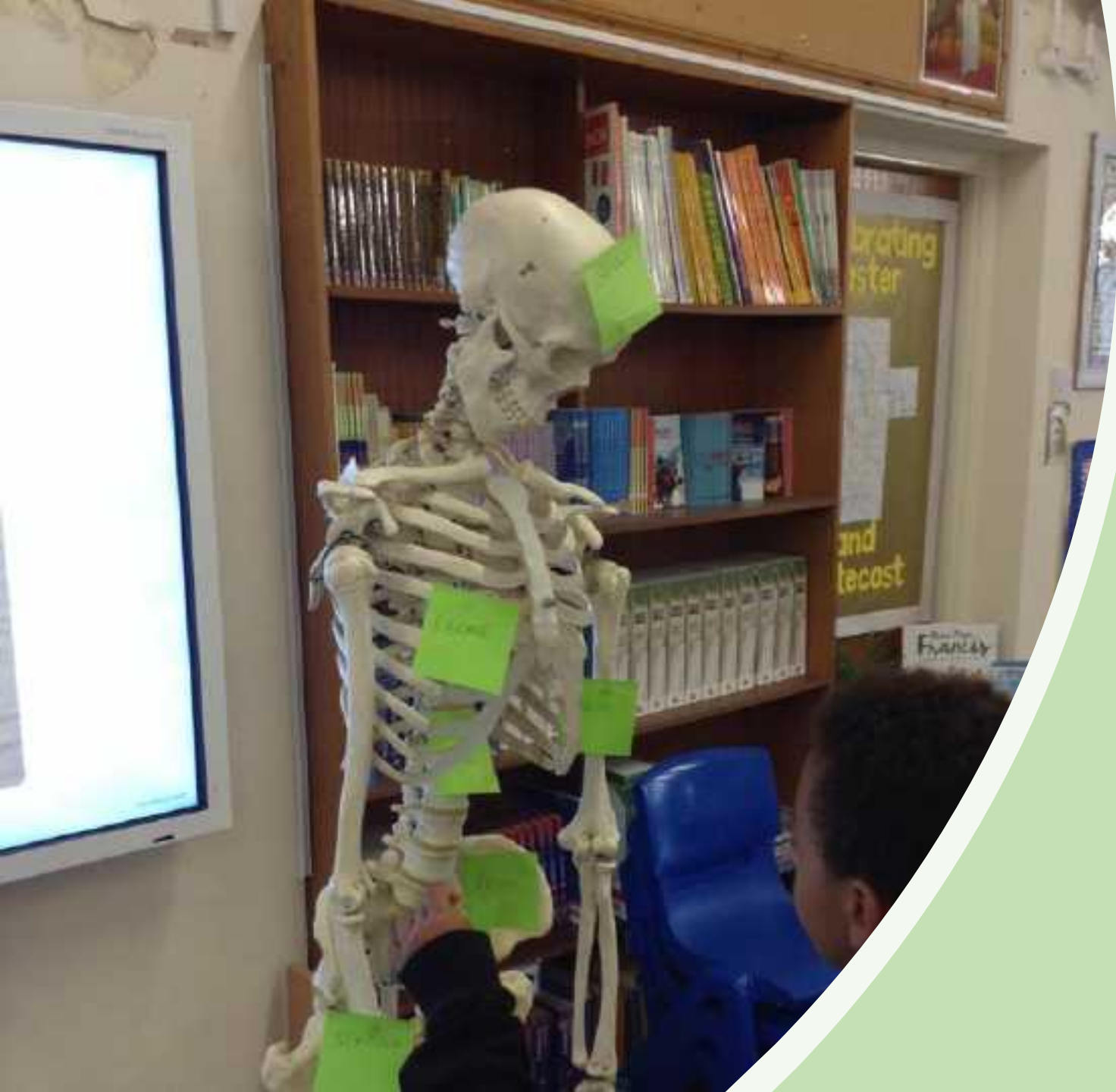

In Science, Year 3 have been learning the names of some of our bones that make up our skeleton.



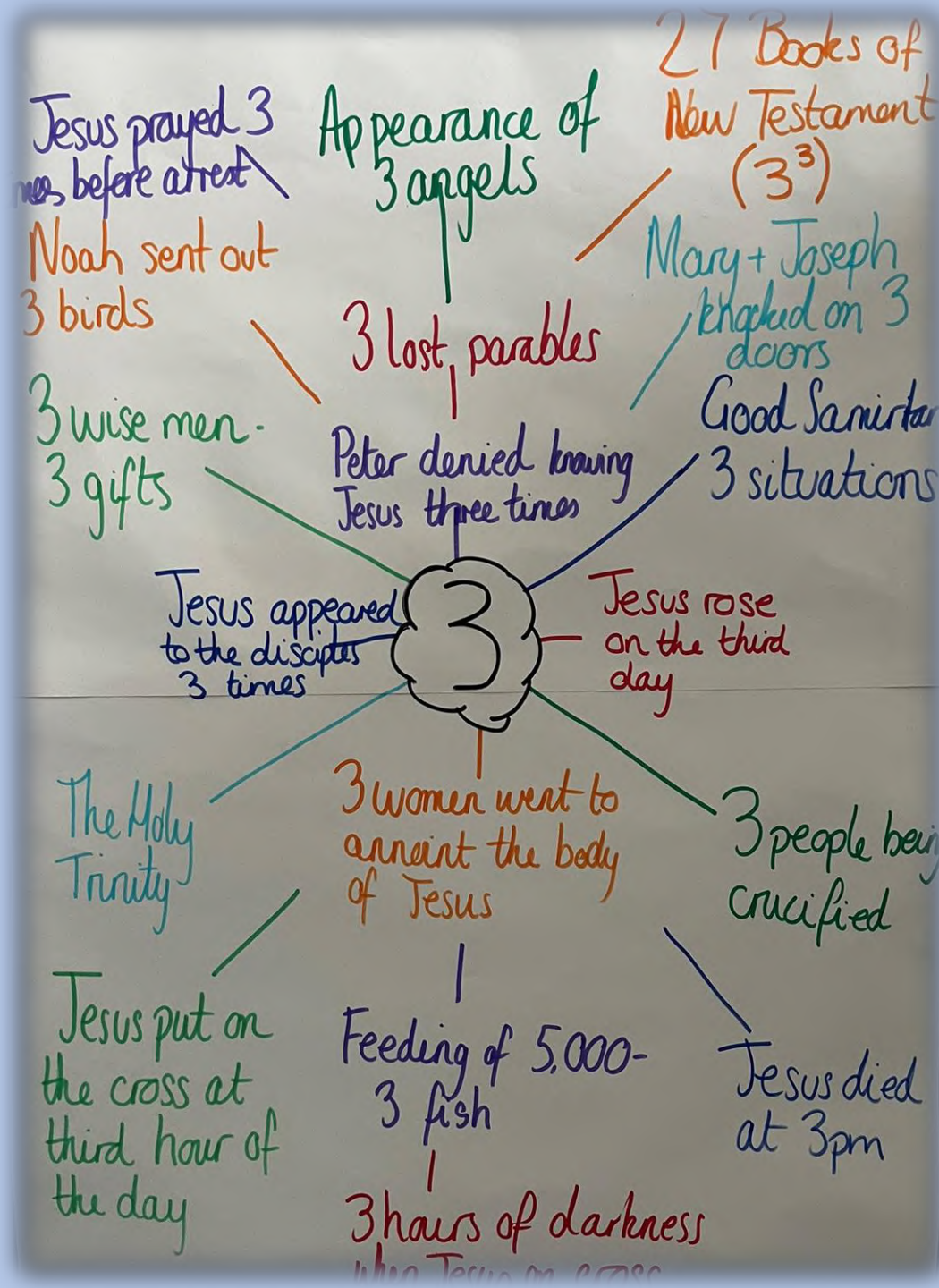
So many talented actors!

They then wrote the instructions for the process.





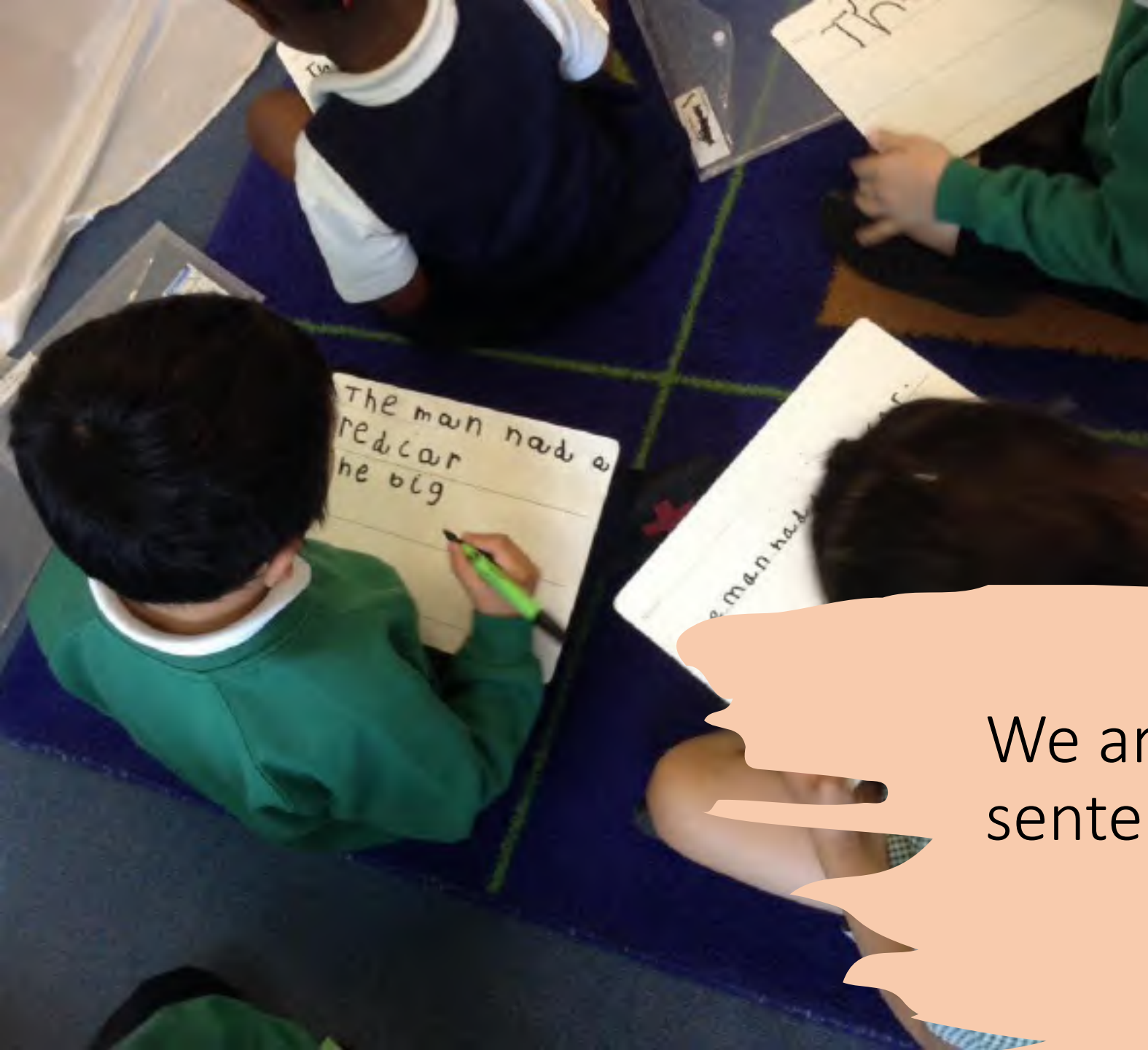
Year One have been learning to find the difference between two numbers in maths this week.
