









The children enjoyed lots of creative opportunities in Reception this week.

A beautiful piece of artwork by one of our Year 5 artists, inspired by the Ascension.

























Rules

This week we really enjoyed the sunshine! We must remember to drink lots of water and wear a sun hat - the best way to protect eyes and delicate skin.







A Word from Pope Francis "Let us walk together taking care of each other and of Creation, our common home. Above all, take care of people in need."




