
Lilian Mapple

French league.


During his time at Paris Saint Germain (PSG), he played

Turtle.


Mapple is known for his incredible speed and his great

of all time) who was just 17.







There has been lots of busy learning in Reception.

Year One have enjoyed their practical Science. Their task was to build a waterproof nest for a woodland creature. They then tested them and discussed properties of materials and how these may have been improved.






The Reception children have been very busy during child initiated learning this week, many showing a particular interest in creating laptops using paper and materials that they can find within the classroom!

always with us.









It was so lovely to see so many parents in class to view their children's work. I am so proud of their achievements and it's wonderful to share!


