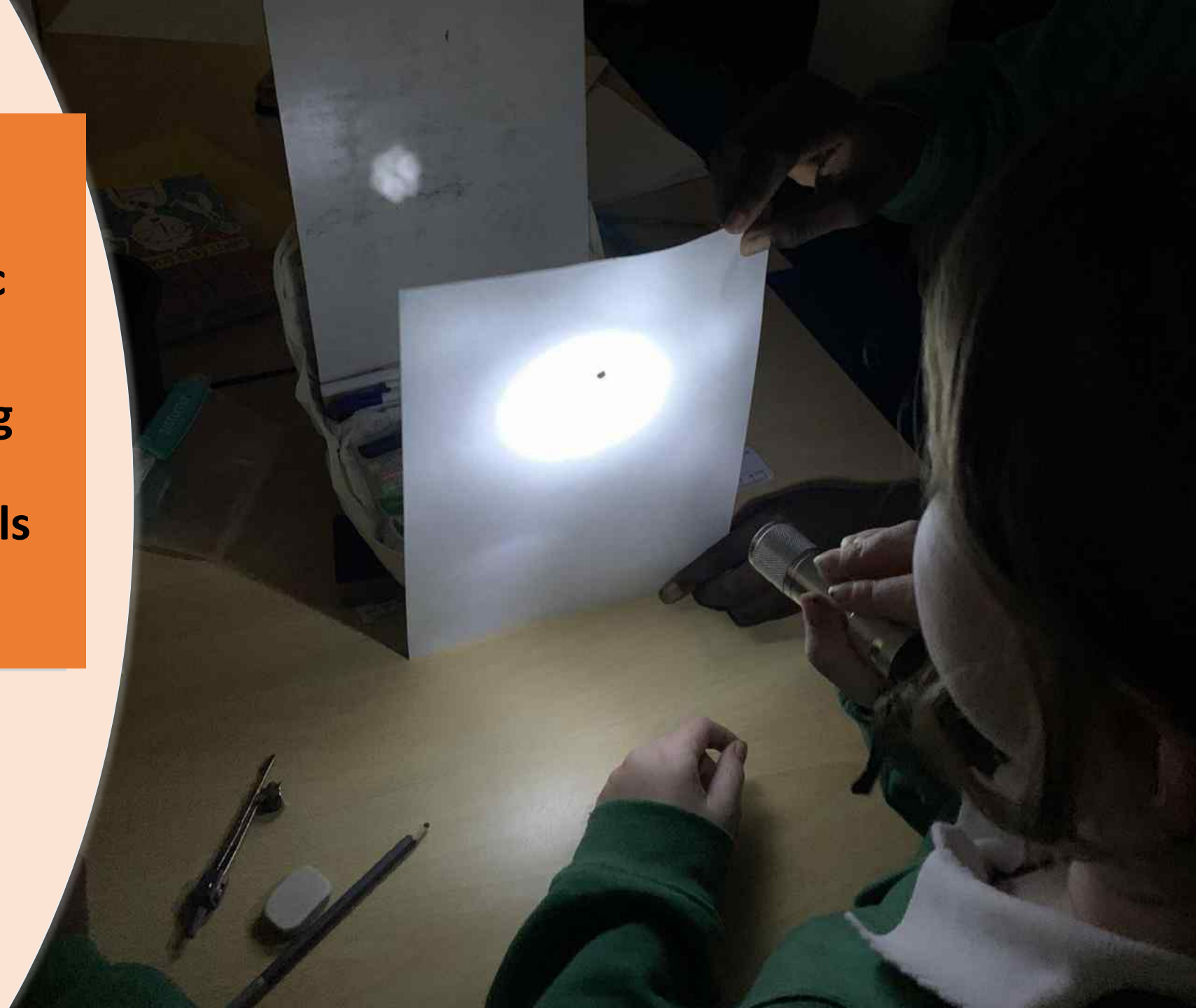


**In response to our new class story, the reception children explored the feelings of the main character. They looked into a mirror and made faces to represent the different emotions. Can you tell what they are?**
