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Reception children are enjoying the outside area. We are developing imaginations, number recognition and fine motor skills.













The children in Year Five Teresa have been learning about our solar system in their science lessons.

Reception have been learning about number bonds to 5 and practising their number formation. Brilliant work, everyone!





The Nursery children have been looking for different sizes and shapes in their environment.







A Word from **Pope Francis**

"If we are close to Jesus, we will have joy in our hearts and a smile on our face."



There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee. The mother of Jesus was there with Jesus and his disciples. When they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." Jesus

said, "Woman why turn to me? My hour has not come yet." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." There were six stone water jars standing there; each could hold twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water," and they filled them to the brim. "Draw some out now," he told them, "and take it to the steward." They did this; the steward tasted the water, and it had turned into the best wine. This was the first of the signs given by Jesus: it was given at Cana in Galilee. He let his glory be seen, and his disciples believed in him.
