The Reception children wrote the story 'The Leopard's Drum' in their own words. Well done everyone!








This week in the Nursery.

In Art Club this week, we created circle art in the style of Kandinsky. You have to agree that their interpretation is fabulous!







After all our hard work this week Reception Mozart enjoyed some time outside playing parachute games. Lots of fun had by all!




Y5 Agnesi had a fab time creating their pop up books with moving mechanisms in DT.








