

Each Friday, we take it in turns to celebrate morning Mass at our neighbouring church, St Joseph's.








On Thursdays, we gather together for our <u>Gospel</u> <u>Assembly</u>.



Year 2 Assumption of Mary art displayed for all to see!






Year 4 has been making mood boards linked to Our Lady, Mary.
