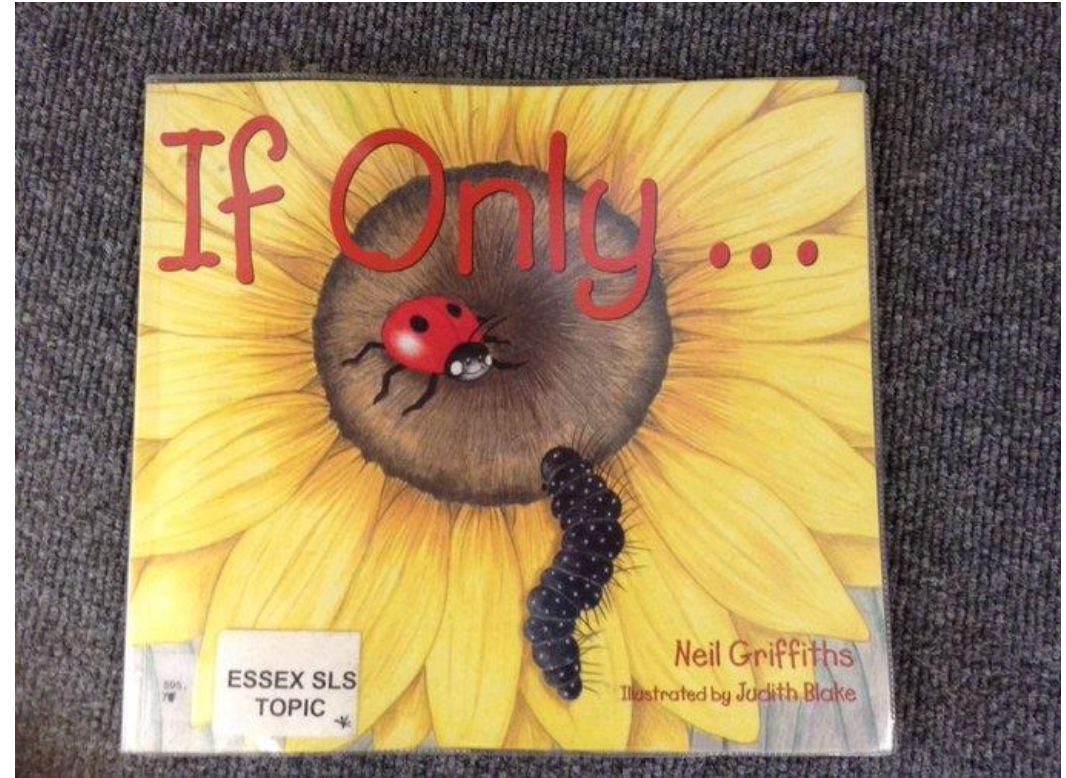

Play the game twice as many.

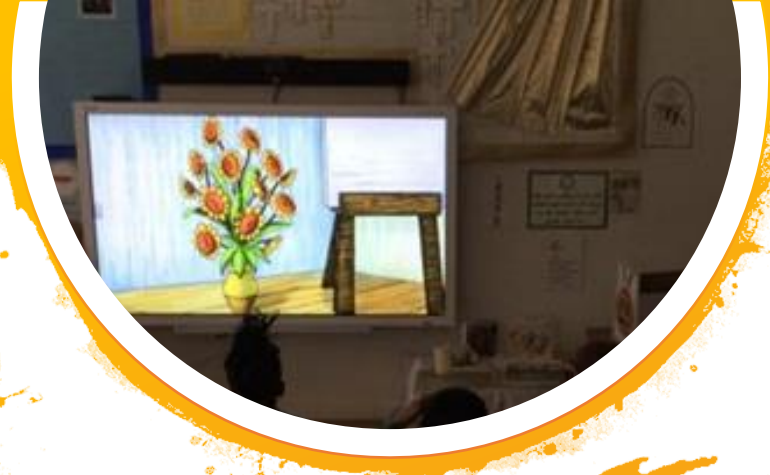
Take it in turns to roll the dice - whatever number you get you need to find twice as many and cover that number on your sheet.

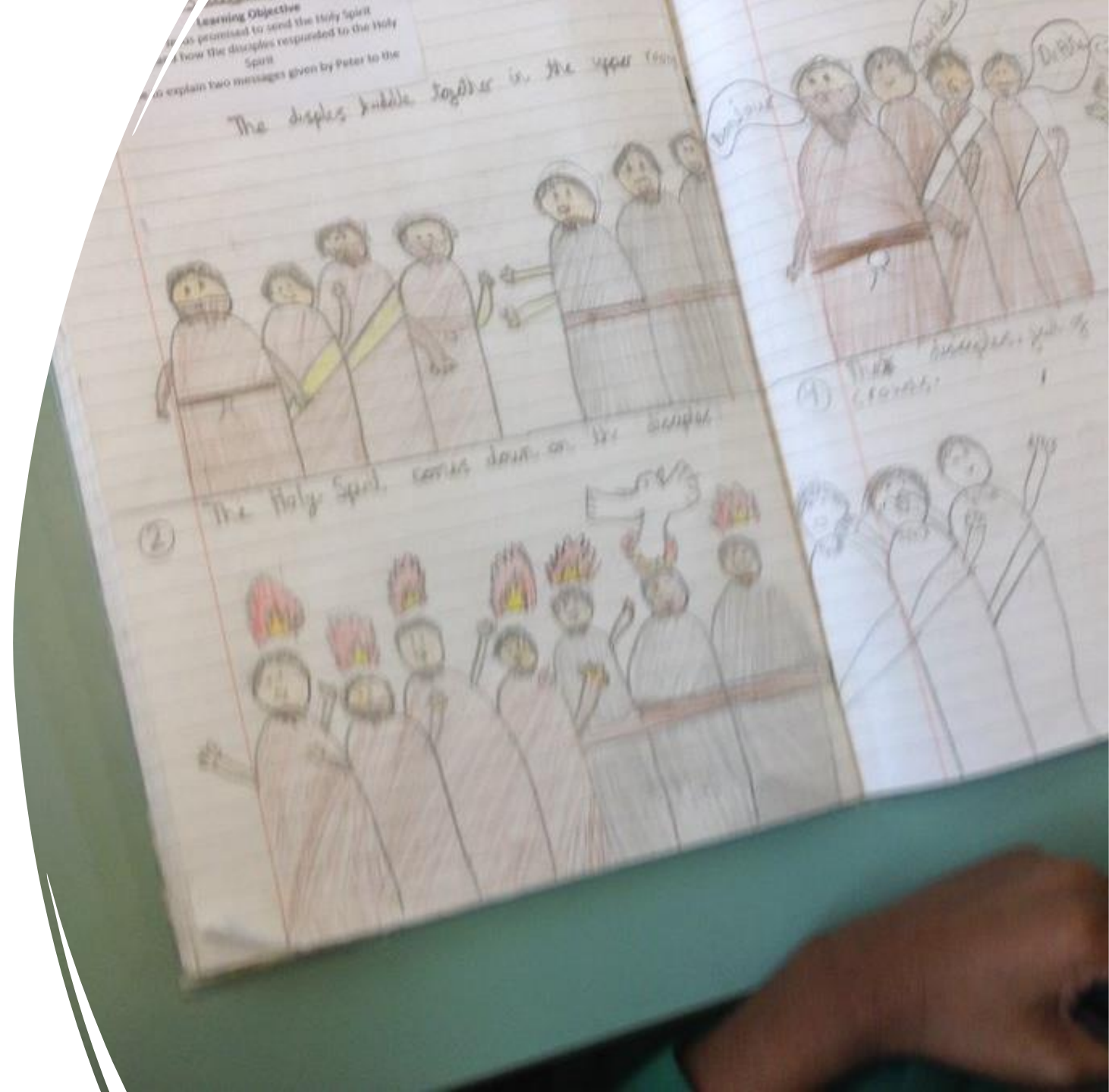
What an engaged and self motivated pupil today in y4! Proactive use of her dictionary, personalised learning and independence a plenty! Bravo!

### Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2021



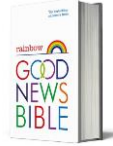
