









In Year 1 we began a new story. Lots of partner talk to generate ideas before we wrote our sentences to predict what might happen in the story - *If only*...

We spent some quiet reflection time whilst we created these.










Year 6 Tolkien thoroughly enjoyed creating chapter titles for what we have read in 'War Horse' so far.


