









Year 5 Teresa have made Promise cards, inspired by King David and his covenant with God.










#### Y5 Agnesi discussed the importance of kindness and created kindness candles for our display.








In English this week the Year 1 children wrote some amazing poems based on our text, **Look Up.**






Children in Year 4 were testing different materials in a circuit to find out which were conductors and which were insulators.

St John Baptist De La Salle


