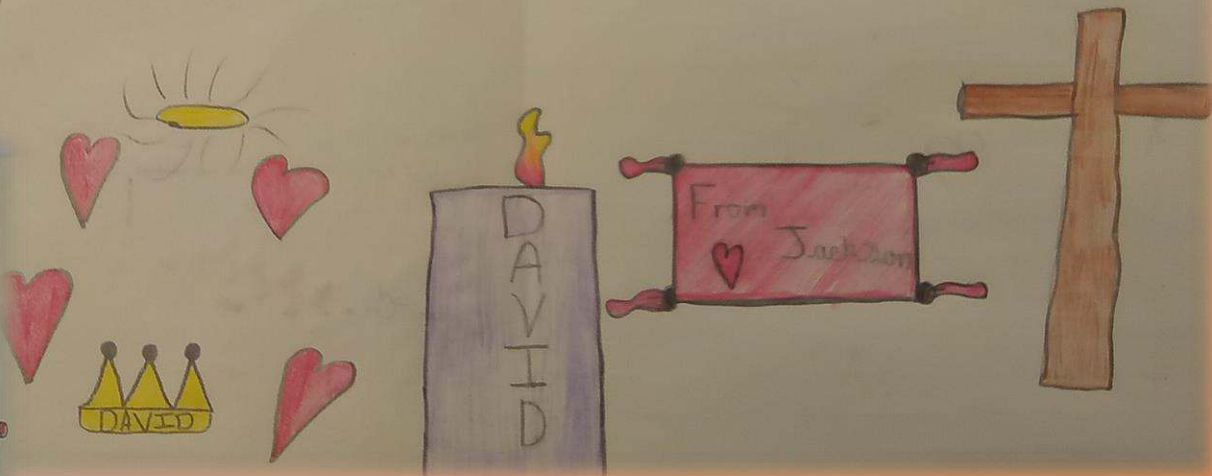
Y5 Agnesi also learnt about the covenant

The children made cards to show the promises David made, and the promises they will keep in their own lives.



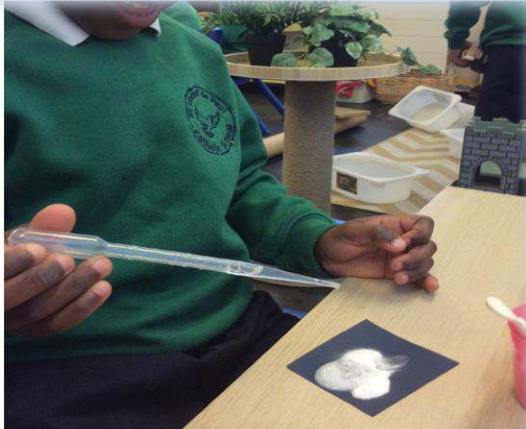
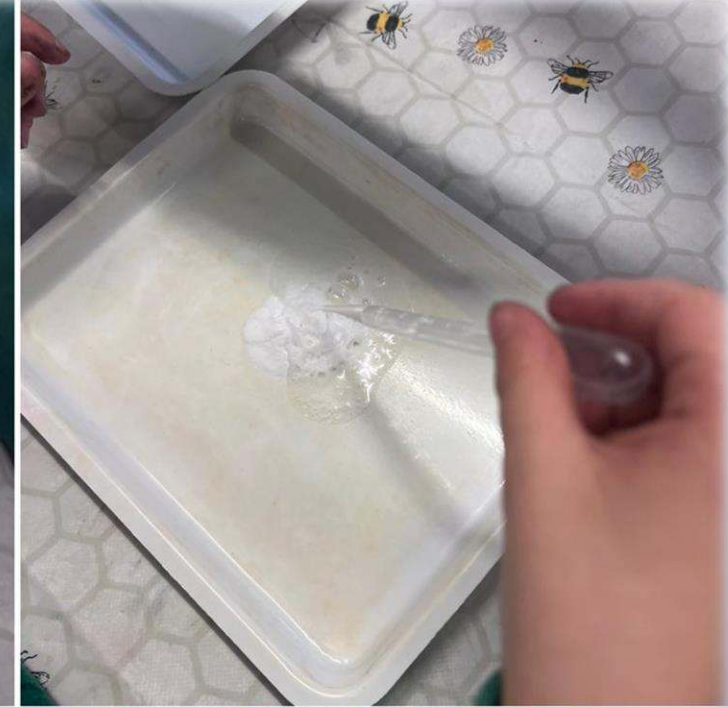

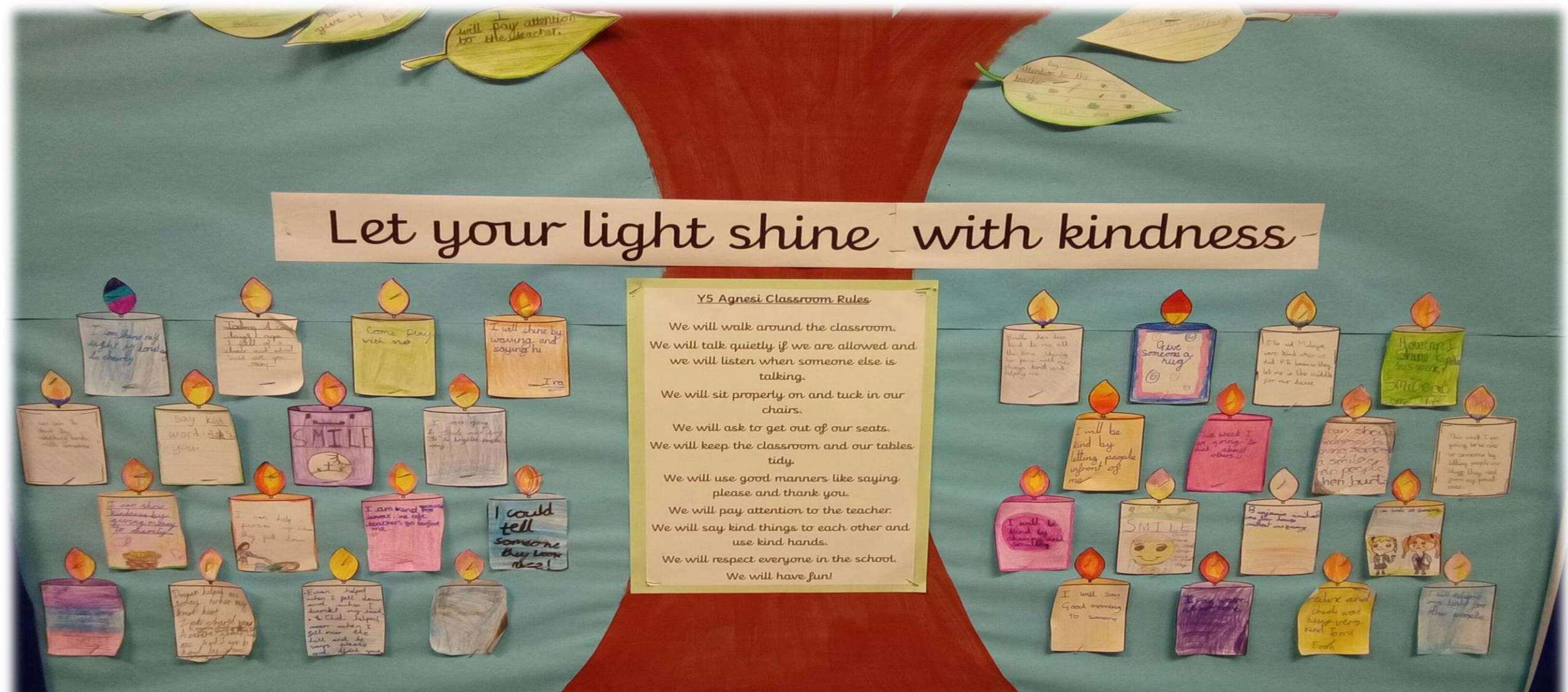


Y5 Agnesi discussed the importance of kindness and created kindness candles for our display.

Children in Year 4 were testing different materials in a circuit to find out which were conductors and which were insulators.

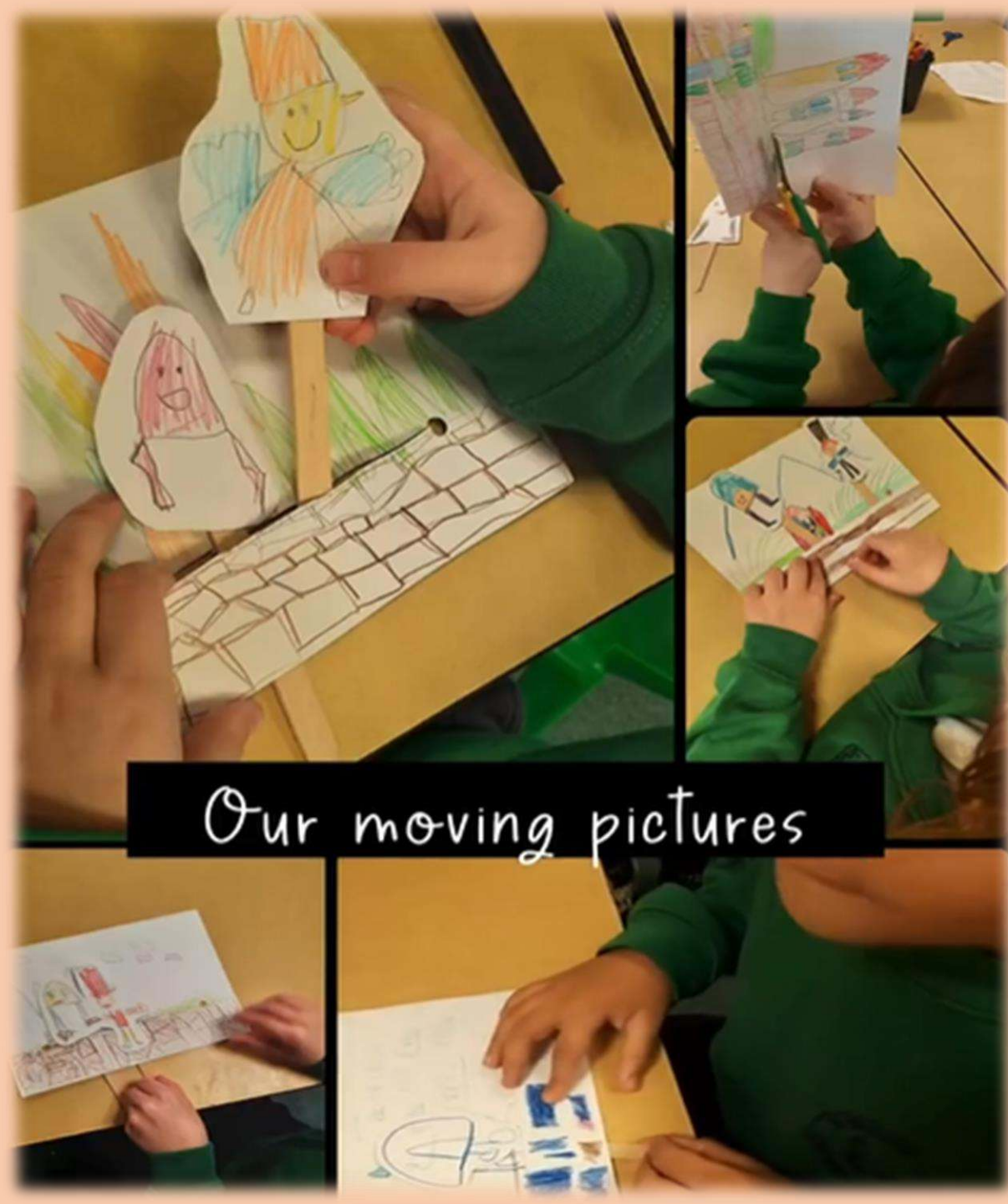

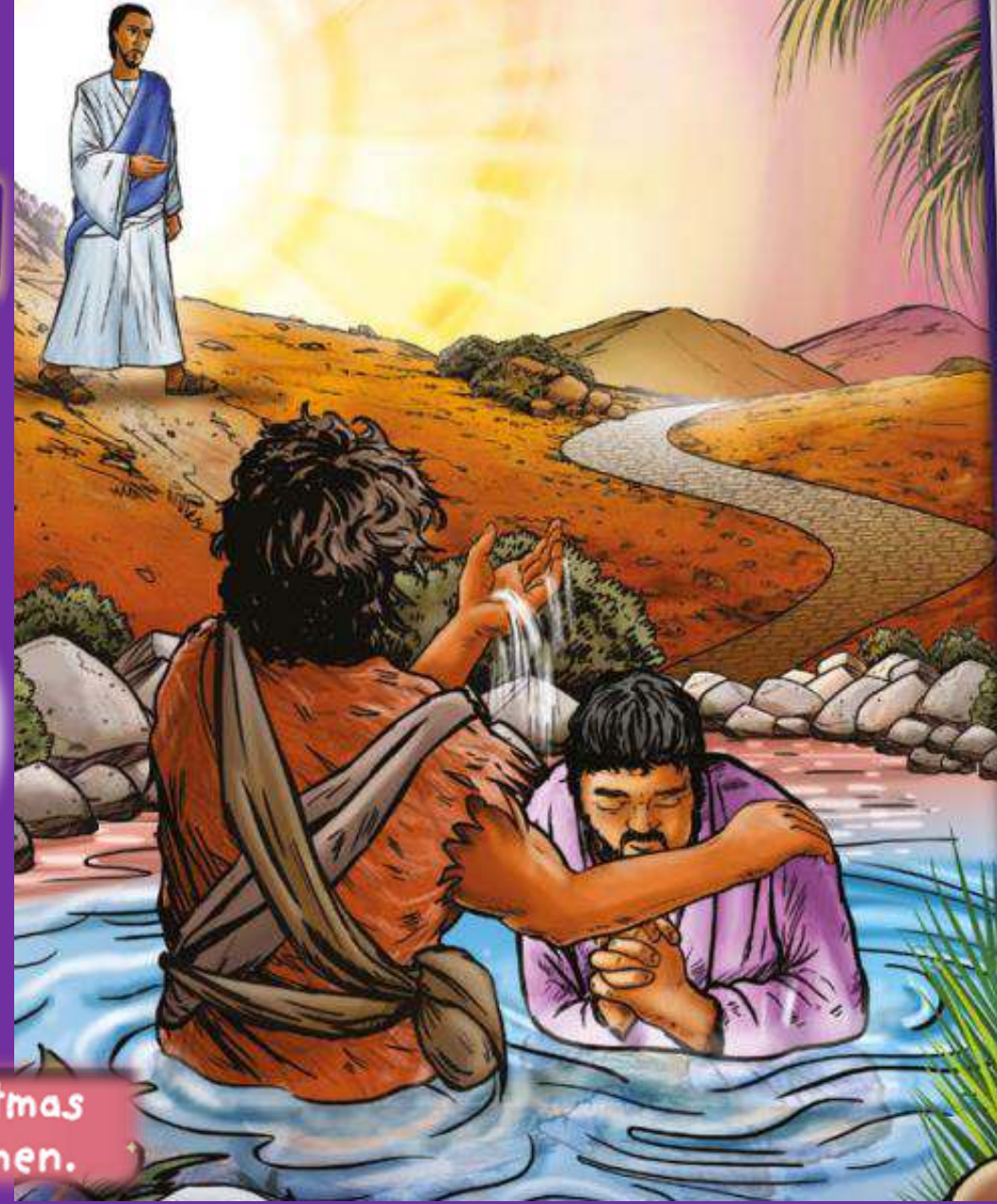
