

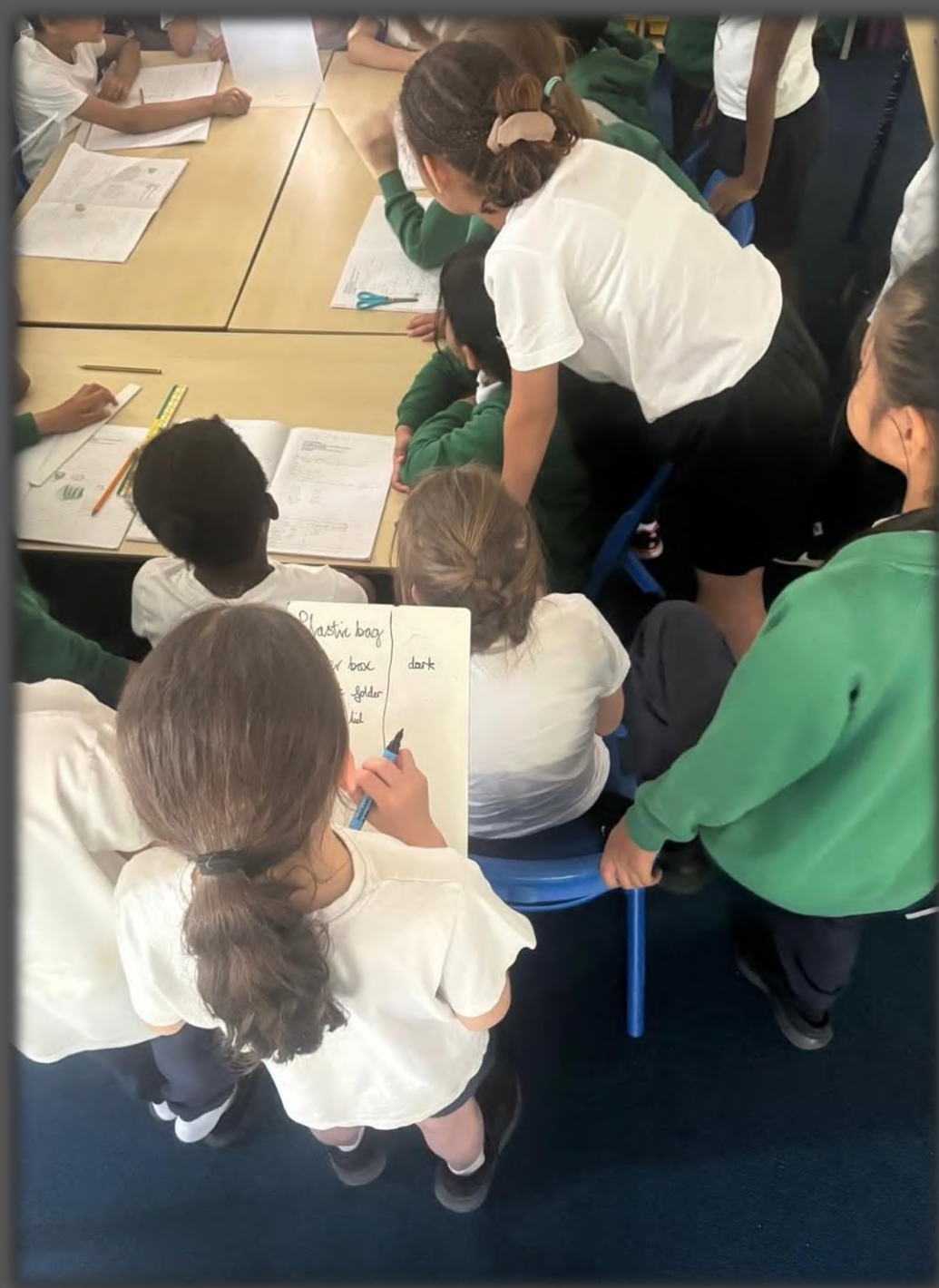

Inquiry question:

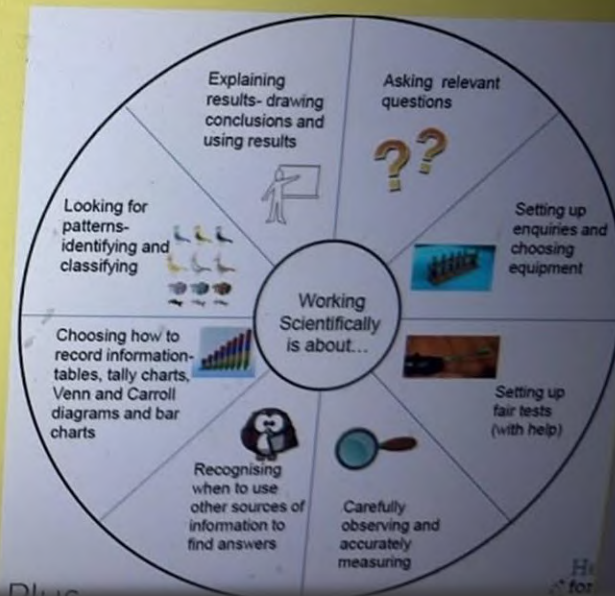
Are shadows the same for all materials?

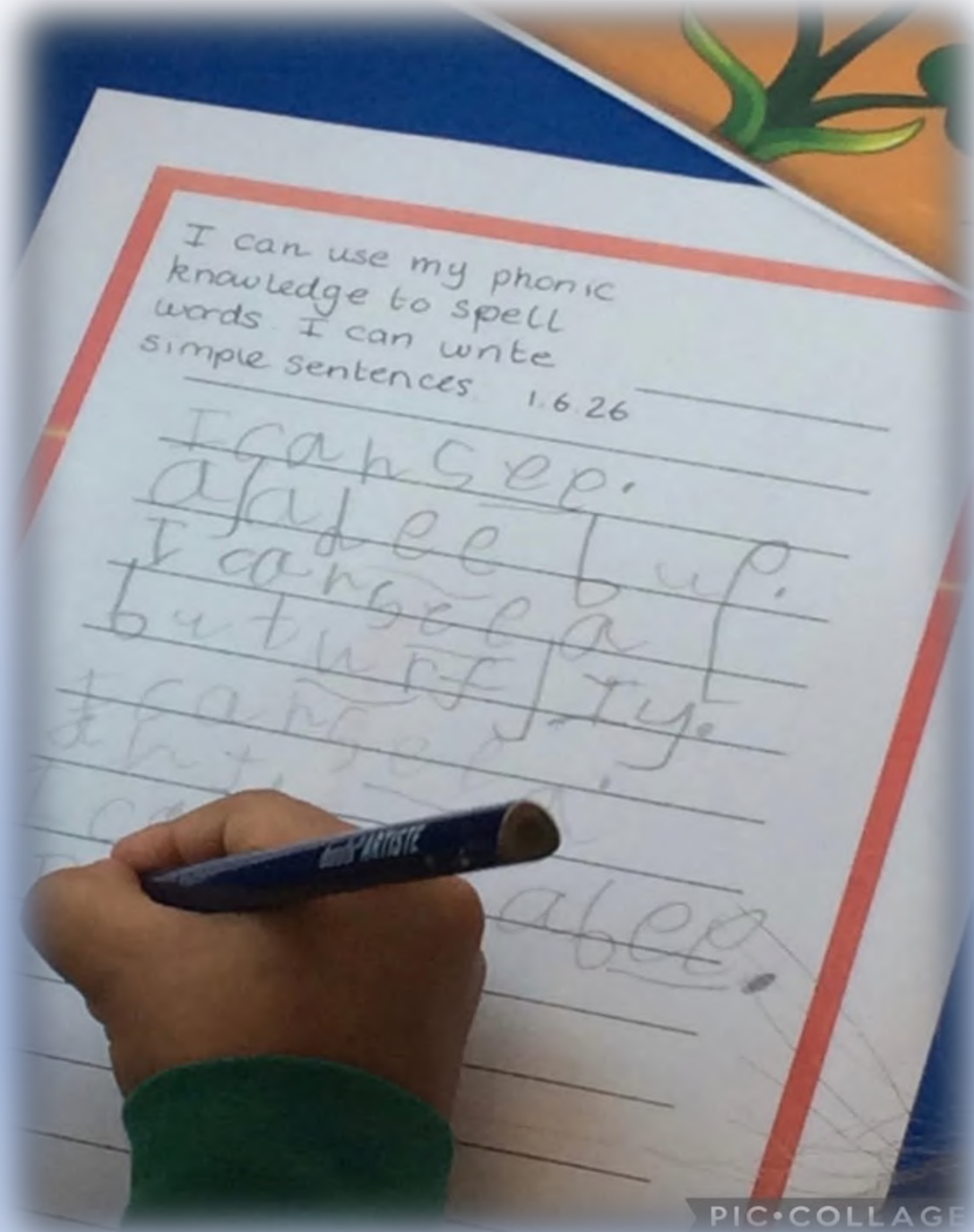
Reception have enjoyed making the most of both our indoor and outdoor learning spaces.

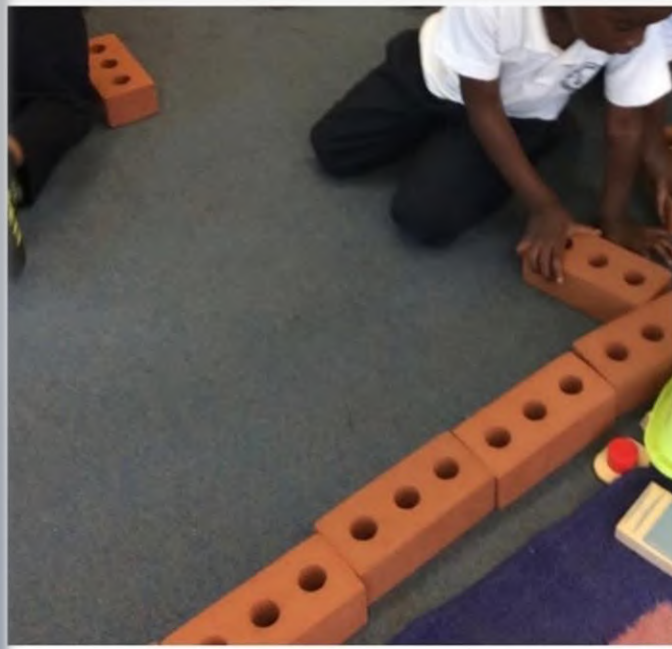
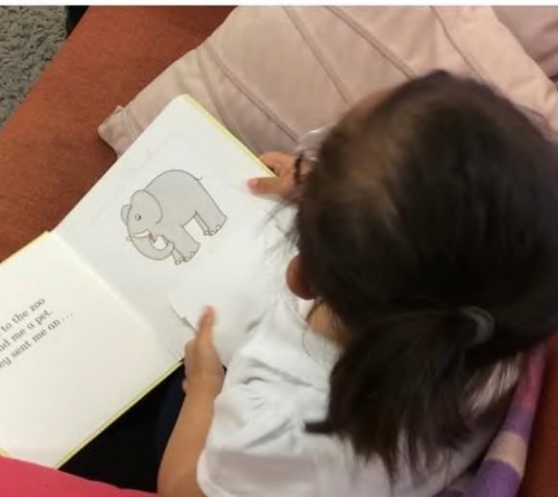
