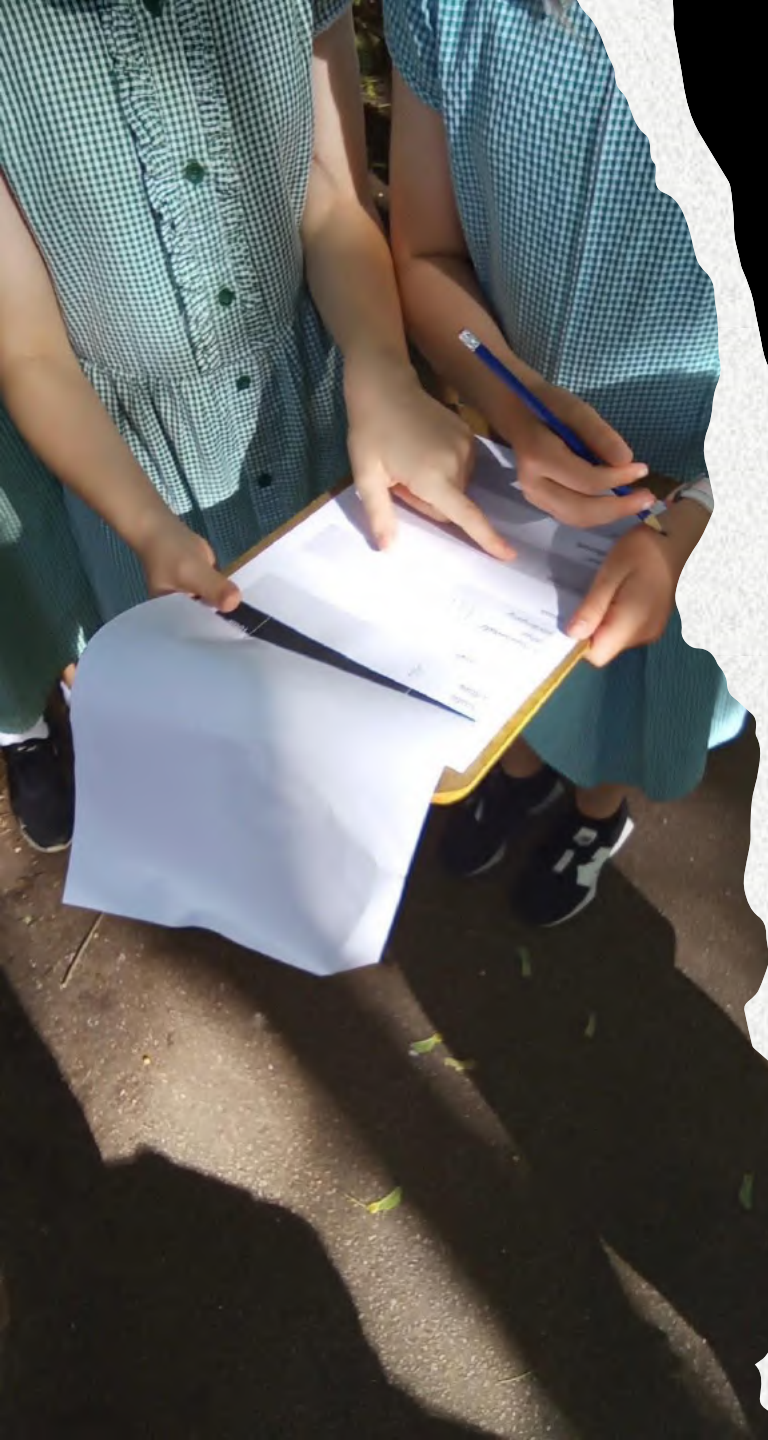


Reception O'Connor enjoyed spending time learning in the outdoor area. The children used the space to explore and investigate, while developing their communication, problem-solving and teamwork skills.
